Full and Half Lease Options Offered



Cost of Leasing

Full Lease

- Full responsibility/rideability
- \$400 per month board
- Lessons (min 1x per week)
- Farrier (depends on your horses shoeing needs)
- Vet (shots, coggins)
- Supplements/special feeding cares

Half Lease

- Shared with another leaser or FSF
- \$200 per month board
- Lessons (min 1x per week)
- Half of all farrier costs
- Half of all vet costs
- Assigned 3 lease days per week

What is a lease?

Leasing a horse is similar to horse ownership, without the initial investment and commitment of a purchase. We offer leases to our current clients who are not yet ready to purchase their own horse.

Am I ready to lease a horse?

Your instructor will be able to help you decide if you are ready to lease, and can give you some options of horses that might be a good fit for you. Not every horse you ride in your lessons will be an appropriate lease option for you for a number of reasons.

Some signs you are ready to lease might be:

- You take regular lessons, at least once a week
- You do practice rides once or twice a week in addition to lessons
- You are able to commit to a full year of working with the same horse
- You understand that owning or leasing a horse involves much more than just riding and taking lessons
